Learn how to work with paper clay, understand how to properly treat clay, both before and after painting, and special techniques that can change the expression on faces. Great for beginners or those with years of experience in other art forms.





#### **Eco Dye with Chelle Doll**

Eco-dyeing has been around for centuries and is both environmentally friendly and works like a dye print in which the image and energy of the plants are transferred to paper. The process can also be applied to fabrics such as silk and cottons. In the Eco-Dye class you will learn what mordant to use, what additives give you different colors, step by step how the process works (hands on, you do your own) and how to finish off your work of art. At the end of the two day class, you will have more than one beauty to take home with you and all the knowledge you need to continue to perfect the art on your own.

### The Art of Alcohol Inks with Anastasia Kenner Thursday, June 20 from 1-4 pm Class fee: \$60 (includes supplies)

Join artist and instructor, Anastasia Kenner, in this 3-hour class to learn the art of alcohol ink painting. Anastasia will teach you how to use these bright and versatile inks to create beautiful, unique landscape and floral paintings you will be proud to display.
