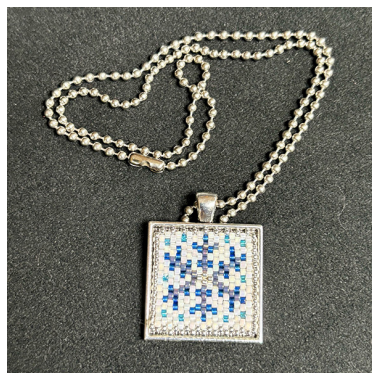
Barn Quilt Workshop with Karin Baker

The pendant will be a snowflake set in a white bead background, held in a black metal frame, hung on an 18" black curbchain. This beautiful piece of jewelry would be a great addition to your wardrobe or gift for family and friends! All supplies needed will be provided including beads, needle, thread and a small bead mat to keep beads under control.

Gelli Plate Arts Class with Vicky Hammel

Saturday, September 21 from 1 to 3:30 pm

Class fee: \$90 for BAGA members or \$50 if you bring your own gelli plate and brayer \$95 for non-members or \$55 if you bring your own gelli plate and brayer

Explore how to make monoprints with a gel plate which is versatile for making prints using acrylic paints, inks, water colors, alcohol inks, water soluble markers and much more. We will use plant material, feathers, bubble, netting, stencils and more to create textures. By the end of class you will have made many papers that can be made into collage, cards, framed art, and more. Supplies include an 8 X 10 Gelli Arts plate and brayer to take home. If you already own these items and plan to bring them to class, you may sign up for instruction only, and select the lower class fee.
