The workshop encourages a pace of mindful making, inviting participants to slow down and experience weaving as a thoughtful, reflective act. Participants will learn fundamental weaving techniques, composition, and the emotive qualities of color, culminating in a completed woven piece inspired by the North Dakota landscape.
