Topics covered include: Similarities and differences of gouache to other painting mediums like watercolor, acrylic and oil; The setup used to create a gouache

painting, including supplies; How to preserve your painting.
Supply List:

Brushes - Recommended brushes for water medium. Flat, filbert, and round

- Gouache Paints Any professional gouache paint set consisting of at least the primary colors and white will work.
- Painting Surface any material intended for water-based medium should work such as heavy watercolor paper, illustration board or watercolor panel.
- A subject to paint. This class will not be focused on a specific subject but instead the techniques to make any painting. If the subject is complicated, it might be good to sketch it out on your painting surface before the class.

• Optional supplies: spray bottle, easel

#### Botanicals in Micron Pen with Laura Allen Saturday, June 28, 9 am to 1 pm

Come draw botanicals in pen and ink! In this 4-hour morning workshop, we'll explore techniques using fine-line inking pens while honing our skill at capturing detail. Pens such as Pigma Micron lend themselves to endless nuance of line and shading, and adding them to your toolbox can be a real boost to your overall art practice. Plus, it's fun! We'll spend some time covering hatching, stippling, and shading. as well as good foundational drawing techniques. Then we'll choose a single interesting botanical specimen and work on a finished drawing.



### Watercolors with Karen Bakke Tuesday, August 12, 1 to 4 pm Class Fee: \$35 BAGA members; \$40 non-members

Bring your own supplies (see below)

This 3 hour mini workshop will explore the use of a variety of watercolor techniques to enhance any art piece. From basics to unconventional tools, you will leave with a journel reference of information to use when creating your next painting. We will conclude by creating a final painting of your choice, using your newly acquired skills.

Suggested watercolor supplies: (you will work with what you have or borrow mine)

- Paint (minimum of 3 colors red blue yellow)
- Brushes, rags, tissues, spritzer spray bottle, tooth picks, q-tips
- Board and masking tape or staple gun to adhere paper down, water containers
- Reference photos or idea for final painting (not necessary)
- 5 plus watercolor canvases and or watercolor paper (5 x 7 to 11 x14)

(the higher quality paper will give better results) (hot, cold, rough, watercolor canvas)

- Apron (we may get messy)
- Notebook and 2 pencils/pen/fine sharpie marker
- Hair dryer (not necessary)
